- 1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise (MSE) as per latest orders issued by Ministry of MSME, the bidder shall be exempted from the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder itself is MSE OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking exemption from Turnover, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption.

 2. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is DPIIT Registered OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking exemption from Turnover shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption.
- 3. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
- 4. Years of Past Experience required: The bidder must have experience for number of years as indicated above in bid document (ending month of March prior to the bid opening) of providing similar type of services to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU. Copies of relevant contracts / orders to be uploaded along with bid in support of having provided services during each of the Financial year.
- 5. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference for services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price. The buyers are advised to refer to the OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023 for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if the credentials of the service provider are validated online in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by the Buyer after evaluation of submitted documents.

 6. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price.
- 7. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.
- 8. Past Experience of Similar Services: The bidder must have successfully executed/completed similar Services over the last three years i.e. the current financial year and the last three financial years(ending month of March prior to the bid opening): -
- 1. Three similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 40% (forty percent) of the estimated cost; or
- 2. Two similar completed services costing not less than the amount equal to 50% (fifty percent) of the estimated cost; or
- 3. One similar completed service costing not less than the amount equal to 80% (eighty percent) of the estimated cost.

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25

percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration

2. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

The tenderer should submit the following towards Pre- Qualification Criteria:

- 1. Service provider or the party or the individual who clearly owns the travel agency while placing the offer for the tender should provide registration certificate of owning the travel agency.
- 2. Service provider or the party or the individual who clearly owns the travel agency while placing t he offer for the tender should provide documentary evidence of owning a minimum 3 or more vehi cles (Copy of Registration of vehicles) same as referred in the Annexure I & III, registered either in individual owner's or travel's name under the aegis of which the offer for the tender will be placed.
- 3. Service provider should have minimum 5 years experience in providing contract taxi cars on con tract basis in the last four years along with the completion certificate or the service provider alrea dy holding a running contract for providing similar type of contract vehicle to any reputed private/ Govt./PSUs institutions/organizations for which documentary proof for the same have to be submit ted wherein, the value of work order should not be less than ₹2,26,700/-. Bidder shall submit documentary proof of work order along with completion certificate.

Definition of Similar work(s): Similar works means works involving in engagement of light motor v ehicles like Honda Amaze /Swift Desire/Innova/Innova Crysta/Traveller/Van/Mini Bus etc

- 4. Firm or individual should give an undertaking that they/he will provide/arrange any type of vehicle same as referred in the Annexure I & III by IREL. The cars should be available for use and should not be registered earlier than 01.07.2024 and total Kilometers run shall not be more than 50,000.
- 5. Average annual financial turnover during the last 3 years, ending 31st March 2024, should be at least ₹1,36,020/-. (Documentary proof for meeting PQC should be enclosed). Bidder shall submit a uthenticated documentary proof of profit & loss account duly signed by auditor (Chartered Account tant or IT Returns) for the last 3 years ending 31st March, 2024.

Note:

- 1. In the absence of receipt of documents meeting to Pre-qualification criteria, the offer will not be considered under any circumstances.
- 2. Relaxation in prior turnover and prior experience shall be given to MSEs / Start-ups (as defined by Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion) as per Government Circular / Guidelines subject to meeting of quality and technical Specification.
- 3. The offers of the bidders who have defaulted in the past in execution of the contracts or in complying with the obligations as per the contract shall not be considered.
- 4. Traders/ distributors/ sole agent/ Works Contract are excluded from the purview of the Procure ment Policy for Micro and small Enterprises, 2012 (as amended time to time).
- 5. Bidder must quote the Grand Total (Part A + Part B + Part C) value in ₹____/-as said in "Price sc hedule" in Price bid.

OTHER TERMS & CONDITIONS

1.0 Bidders have to upload the following along with the Bid

- (i) Documents towards pre qualification of tender failing which offer shall not be accepted.
- (ii) Copy of GST, PAN, MSME Registration
- (iii) EMD Declaration
- (iv) Undertaking provided in tender, duly filled and signed
- (v) Contact details with e-mail, Phone no. etc.
- 2.0 Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)
- 2.1 Tenderer shall remit EMD through RTGS/ NEFT infavour of M/s IREL (India) Limited, Manavalaku richi.
- 2.2 Tenderer shall inform details of remittance of EMD & TDC through E-Mail/ FAX. The E-mail shou ld contain full postal address of the Tenderer, Tender No. for which EMD & TDC were paid, paymen t details including amount, and UTR No. and bank details from which payment was done. IREL's E mail id is purchase-mk@irel.co.in
- 2.3 Incase tenderer is submitting BG in lieu of EMD the same shall be strictly in the format given in the tender. The Original BG shall reach this office at least 3 days in advance from the date of open ing of Techno-Commercial Bid.
- 2.4 Offers without EMD or valid EMD exemption certificate shall not be considered.
- 2.5 The EMD is liable to be forfeited if:
- i. The tenderer changes the terms and conditions or prices or withdraw his quotation subsequent t o the date of opening.
- ii. The tenderer fails to accept the order when placed or fails to commence supplies/works after accepting the order.
- iii. In case bidder submits false/fabricated documents.
- iv. In case bidder fails to submit SD within 30 days of receipt of work/supply order.
- 2.6 PSU, State Govt. Undertakings are exempted from payment of EMD subject to request and ap proval. MSME /SSI units—are exempted from payment of EMD/ TDC—provided they submit valid MSME/ NSIC certificate along with commercial bid and to ensure that certificate pertains to the class of item/works for which floated.
- 3.0 SECURITY DEPOSIT (SD)
- 3.1 Security deposit (SD) shall be uniformly levied @ 5% of contract value (excluding Taxes) towar ds satisfactory completion of the order/works as under:
- a. For works contract valued more than Rs.2 lakhs.
- b. For supply & service contract valued more than Rs.5 lakhs.

Performance Security is to be furnished by a specified date (generally 14 (fourteen) days after noti fication of the award) and it should remain valid for a period of 60 (sixty) days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations of the supplier/ contractor, including warranty obligations/ defect liability period (DLP).

3.2 Submission of SD/PBG, if called for in the tender can also be paid through Insurance Surety Bo nds' or 'account payee demand draft' or 'fixed deposit receipt from a Scheduled Commercial bank' or 'Bank Guarantee issued/ confirmed from any Scheduled Commercial Banks in India' or online payment to be confirmed sharing Unique Transaction Reference (UTR) to the tender inviting authority as called for in tender.

- 3.3 Bank Guarantees towards Bid Security/ Security Deposit/ PBG issued by Nationalized Banks/ Scheduled Commercial Banks (other than Cooperative Banks) only acceptable.
- 3.4 EMD/ Bid Security may be adjusted towards SD. However, if EMD is submitted in the form of B ank Guarantee, fresh Bank Guarantee in the prescribed format or demand draft/Bankers cheque is to be submitted towards SD.
- 3.5 The SD shall not bear any interest and is liable to be forfeited for unsatisfactory completion or on abandonment of the supply/ work order.

4.0 Period of contract:

The contract shall be for a period of one year. IREL reserves the right to terminate the contract at any time without assigning any reason, for which no compensation shall be paid.

The offer should accompany photocopy of the authentic documentary proof of ownership, fitness, remittance of road tax, comprehensive insurance coverage, PUC etc. of the vehicle intended to be provided by the service provider. However, the successful service provider should produce the ori ginals for all the above documents for our verification before awarding the contract.

All expenses relating to the maintenance of car, periodic service charge of vehicle, fuel expenses, service charges for extra fittings in the vehicle, driver's salary, tax insurance or any other expense s should be in service provider's account. The company shall not accept any liability for the labour directly or indirectly employed by the service provider. The Company shall not be liable to pay da mages of compensation on account of injury or accidents arising during the course of deployment.

The service provider shall comply with all statutory rules & orders of Central Govt., Local authoritie s etc. with respect to Labour laws and other statutory obligations. The service provider shall comp ly with the provisions of the Contract Labour Regulation and Abolition Act 1970 and rules made there under and all other Acts and Rules as applicable.

5.0 Payment Terms:

- i. Payment will be released within 7 working days against the bill duly certified by controlling office r/OIC, subject to deduction of GST as applicable.
- ii. All payments will be done through E-payment mode only. Hence, service provider shall furnish n ame of the account holder, account number, name of the bank, IFSC code, nature of account (savings/current/CC/OD) and branch code along with your first bill.

6.0 Penalty:

- a. If the service provider fails to provide the contract vehicle for IREL any day when requested a pe nalty of ₹1,000/- for Honda Amaze /Swift Desire, ₹1500/- for Innova, ₹2000/- for Innova Crysta / Te mpo traveller vehicles will be recovered.
- b. If there is a delay in the supply of the vehicles, penalty for delaying will be on recovered on eac h hourly basis i.e, ₹200/- for Honda Amaze / Swift Desire, ₹300/- for Innova, ₹400/- for Innova Cryst a/Tempo traveller vehicles will be recovered.
- c. Vehicle with driver shall have to report at a designated place and time which will be intimated by the officer concerned either to the driver or service provider at short notice. Designated reporting place may be changed as per requirement at short notice to either the driver or the service provider. Failing to report on time may lead to penalty of ₹500.00 being imposed.
- d. The vehicles shall strictly comply with the provisions of pollution control, statutory regulation iss ued by State Transport Authorities/ Central Govt. /other authorities etc. from time to time. Service provider shall ensure that the vehicle should have all relevant documents like Registration Certific ate/Driving license/Insurance Cover/Road Tax Receipt /Permit, Pollution certificate, Driver's Licens e and badge etc. Driver should be able to produce documents as and when required from him. Co nsequence of failure to comply with any of the rules and regulations of the concerned authorities s

hall be faced directly by the service provider only. Any penalty on this account by the Police/Trans port authorities will be borne by the service provider.

7.0 LIQUIDATED DAMGES FOR DELAYED EXECUTION OF CONTRACT:

If the Service Provider fails to perform the services within the time period(s) specified in the CONT RACT, the EMPLOYER shall, without prejudice to his other remedies under the CONTRACT, levy Liq uidated damages from the CONTRACT PRICE, a sum calculated on the basis of the CONTRACT PRICE, including subsequent modifications.

Deductions shall apply as per following formula:

Half percent (0.5%) of the contract value per week of delay subject to a maximum of ten percent (10%) of contract value

EMPLOYER may deduct the amount so payable by Service Provider, from any amount falling due t o the Service Provider or by recovery against the Performance Guarantee. Both Service Provider a nd EMPLOYER agree that the above percentages of price reduction are genuine pre-estimates of t he loss/damage which the EMPLOYER would have suffered on account of delay/breach on the part of the Service Provider and the said amount will be payable on demand without there being any pr oof of the actual loss/or damage caused by such breach/delay. A decision of the EMPLOYER in the matter of applicability of price reduction shall be final and binding.

8.0 In case of any discrepancy between Gem ATC and Buyer ATC, terms stipulated in Buyer ATC s hall govern.

9.0 In case of any discrepancy between GeM SLA terms and ATC stipulated by IREL, Terms stipulat ed by IREL shall govern.

10.0 MSE bidders are to carefully indicate their MSE status while bidding. In case any mistake don e by the bidder, evaluation and order shall be done as per GeM provisions only and IREL (India) Li mited shall not be anyway held responsible.

- 8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for attached categories, trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
- 9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
- 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
- 15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
- 16. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
- 17. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

जेम की सामान्य शर्तों के खंड 26 के संदर्भ में भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश के बिडर से खरीद पर प्रतिबंध के संबंध में भारत के साथ भूमि सीमा साझा करने वाले देश का कोई भी बिडर इस निविदा में बिड देने के लिए तभी पात्र होगा जब वह बिड देने वाला सक्षम प्राधिकारी के पास पंजीकृत हो।बिड में भाग लेते समय बिडर को इसका अनुपालन करना होगा और कोई भी गलत घोषणा किए जाने व इसका अनुपालन न करने पर अनुबंध को तत्काल समाप्त करने और कानून के अनुसार आगे की कानूनी कार्रवाई का आधार होगा।/In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority. While participating in bid, Bidder has to undertake compliance of this and any false declaration and non-compliance of this would be a ground for immediate termination of the contract and further legal action in accordance with the laws.
