1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration

PRE-QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

The tenderer should submit the following towards Pre- Qualification Criteria:

1. Bidder shall submit Valid GST, PAN & MSME Registration certificate.

OTHER TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1.0 Bidders have to upload the following along with the Bid
- (i) Documents towards pre qualification of tender failing which offer shall not be accepted.
- (ii) Copy of Valid GST, PAN, MSME Registration
- (iii) EMD Declaration
- (iv) Undertaking provided in tender, duly filled and signed
- (v) Contact details with e-mail, Phone no. etc.

- 2.0 The rate quoted shall be FOR IREL (India) Limited, Manavalakurichi. The items have to be supplied strictly as per the technical specification within the delivery period mentioned in the tender.
- 3.0 Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)
- 3.1 ₹93,492/- (Rupees Ninety three thousand four hundred and ninety two only)
- 3.2 Tenderer shall remit EMD through RTGS/ NEFT infavour of M/s IREL (India) Limited, Manavalakurichi.
- 3.3 Tenderer shall inform details of remittance of EMD & TDC through E-Mail/ FAX. The E-mail should conta in full postal address of the Tenderer, Tender No. for which EMD & TDC were paid, payment details includin g amount, and UTR No. and bank details from which payment was done. IREL's Email id is purchase-mk@ir el.co.in
- 3.4 Incase tenderer is submitting BG in lieu of EMD the same shall be strictly in the format given in the ten der. The Original BG shall reach this office at least 3 days in advance from the date of opening of Techno-C ommercial Bid.
- 3.5 Offers without EMD or valid EMD exemption certificate shall not be considered.
- 3.6 The EMD is liable to be forfeited if:
- i. The tenderer changes the terms and conditions or prices or withdraw his quotation subsequent to the dat e of opening.
- ii. The tenderer fails to accept the order when placed or fails to commence supplies/works after accepting the order.
- iii. In case bidder submits false/fabricated documents.
- iv. In case bidder fails to submit SD within 30 days of receipt of work/supply order.
- 3.7 PSU, State Govt. Undertakings are exempted from payment of EMD subject to request and approval. M SME /SSI units—are exempted from payment of EMD/ TDC—provided they submit valid MSME/ NSIC certific ate along with commercial bid and to ensure that certificate pertains to the class of item/works for which floated.
- 4.0 Security Deposit (SD)
- 4.1 Security deposit (SD) shall be uniformly levied @ 5% of contract value (excluding Taxes) towards sati sfactory completion of the order/works as under:
- a. For works contract valued more than ₹2 lakhs.
- b. For supply & service contract valued more than ₹5 lakhs.

Performance Security is to be furnished by a specified date (generally 14 (fourteen) days after notification of the award) and it should remain valid for a period of 60 (sixty) days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations of the supplier/ contractor, including warranty obligations/ defect liability period (D LP).

- 4.2 Submission of SD/PBG, if called for in the tender can also be paid through Insurance Surety Bonds' or 'account payee demand draft' or 'fixed deposit receipt from a Scheduled Commercial bank' or 'Bank Guara ntee issued/ confirmed from any Scheduled Commercial Banks in India' or online payment to be confirmed sharing Unique Transaction Reference (UTR) to the tender inviting authority as called for in tender.
- 4.3 Bank Guarantees towards Bid Security/ Security Deposit/ PBG issued by Nationalized Banks/ Scheduled Commercial Banks (other than Cooperative Banks) only acceptable.
- 4.4 EMD/ Bid Security may be adjusted towards SD. However, if EMD is submitted in the form of Bank Guar antee, fresh Bank Guarantee in the prescribed format or demand draft/Bankers cheque is to be submitted towards SD.
- 4.5 The SD shall not bear any interest and is liable to be forfeited for unsatisfactory completion or on aban donment of the supply/ work order.
- 5.0 period of Contract:

The period of contract shall be two month from the date of start of work or till completion of the entire qua

ntity, whichever is earlier. However, contractor shall start the work within 3 days or as directed by Enginee r-In-Charge.

6.0 Payment Terms:

- a. Payment to the contractor for the work done will be made fortnightly on submission of bills and after the verification of actual work done with weigh bridge statement generated by stores department within 30 d ays from the submission of bills complete in all respect certified by Engineer-In-charge subject to deduction of tax at source as applicable.
- b. No mobilization advance shall be allowed as a general rule.
- c. GST Law mandates Tax Deduction at Source (TDS) vide Section 51 of the GST/SGST Act 2017, Section 20 of the IGST Act, 2017 and Section 21 of the UTGST Act, 2017.
- d. Please mention IREL (India) Limited GST number (33AAACI2799F1ZL) and HSN/SAC code of goods/servic es in your bills.
- e. All payments shall be done only through E-payment. Hence successful bidder has to provide Company n ame, Account number, Name of the bank.

7.0 Penalty:

- 7.1 For achieving the targeted quantity, the contractor shall deploy excavators and tippers continuously. H owever, if failure of any equipment occurs due to any emergency / breakdown, then it shall be the respons ibility of the contractor to immediately make alternate arrangement to mobilize spare excavators, tippers in good working condition, either of his own or hired from outside agencies. The contractor shall ensure that the checking of the spare equipment by company official is completed before inducting the same in the existing fleet. In case the contractor fails to mobilize spare equipments as mentioned above in good working condition within 3 days, he shall be liable to pay penalty ⊚ ₹5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) plus applic able Goods & Service Tax per equipment for each day of shortfall of equipment from 4th day onwards till such time the equipment is mobilized.
- 7.2 The contractors should note that this tender is linked to mainly agreements made with various private land owners after obtaining consent to temporary leasing for mining at inland deposits. Therefore timely b ackfilling of tails is of paramount importance to ensure timely handing over of land to respective land own ers.

8.0 Liquidated Damages for Delayed Execution of Contract:

If the Service Provider fails to perform the services within the time period(s) specified in the CONTRACT, the EMPLOYER shall, without prejudice to his other remedies under the CONTRACT, levy Liquidated damages from the CONTRACT PRICE, a sum calculated on the basis of the CONTRACT PRICE, including subsequent modifications.

Deductions shall apply as per following formula:

Half percent (0.5%) of the contract value per week of delay subject to a maximum of ten percent (10%) of contract value

EMPLOYER may deduct the amount so payable by Service Provider, from any amount falling due to the Service Provider or by recovery against the Performance Guarantee. Both Service Provider and EMPLOYER agree that the above percentages of price reduction are genuine pre-estimates of the loss/damage which the EMPLOYER would have suffered on account of delay/breach on the part of the Service Provider and the said amount will be payable on demand without there being any proof of the actual loss/or damage caused by such breach/delay. A decision of the EMPLOYER in the matter of applicability of price reduction shall be fin all and binding.

10.0 In case of any discrepancy between Gem ATC and Buyer ATC, terms stipulated in Buyer ATC shall go vern.

11.0 In case of any discrepancy between GeM SLA terms and ATC stipulated by IREL, Terms stipulated by IREL shall govern.

12.0 MSE bidders are to carefully indicate their MSE status while bidding. In case any mistake done by the bidder, evaluation and order shall be done as per GeM provisions only and IREL (India) Limited shall not be anyway held responsible.

- 9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
- 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
- 15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
- 16. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
- 17. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
