3. Bidding Schedule

IREL shall endeavour to adhere to the schedule provided for under this clause. However, in case IREL in its sole discretion undertakes any modification in the schedule specified below, the same shall be notified from time to time on the tendering/IREL website. 4. Definitions

- 4.1.1. **Mineral sands** or **Total Heavy Mineral** shall have its meaning as defined in sub-rule (1) of rule 2 of Atomic Minerals Concession Rules, 2016.
- 4.1.2. **Mine Lease** or **Mining Lease** means the mining lease in connection with the Heavy Mineral deposit located in Brahmagiri tahasil of Puri District, Odisha. LOI for the lease has been issued by the Govt of Odisha to IREL. The agreement is to be executed between IREL and the Government of Odisha in accordance with the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957, Atomic Minerals Concession Rules, 2016 and shall include any lease renewals/ extensions thereof.
- 4.1.3. **Mine** shall refer to the mine corresponding to Brahmagiri Mine Lease.
- 4.1.4. **Mineral Sand** shall mean the raw sand available in the Lease Area comprising of Beach Sand Minerals.
- 4.1.5. **MDO** shall mean Mine Developer and Operator.
- 4.1.6. R & R shall mean Resettlement and Rehabilitation.
- 4.1.7. **HM** shall mean Heavy mineral.

5. Introduction and Background

IREL (India) Limited (IREL), a Mini-Ratna Category-I company, is a Public Sector Enterprise of the Government of India under the administrative control of the Department of Atomic Energy, Govt of India. The company is engaged in mining and separation of Mineral sands to produce Ilmenite, Rutile, Zircon, Sillimanite, Monazite, Garnet, Leucoxene, Rare earth compounds etc. The operating units of the company are located at Chavara, Kerala; Manavalakurichi, Tamil Nadu; Chatrapur, Odisha and Aluva, Kerala.

6. Objective of IREL

The Government of Odisha has issued a Letter of Intent to IREL for grant of mining lease for Mineral Sands in favour of IREL in Brahmagiri tahasil of Puri District, Odisha. The Mine Lease extends along the coastline of Bay of Bengal containing an assemblage of heavy minerals viz. Ilmenite, Rutile, Zircon, Monazite, Garnet & Sillimanite.

IREL plans to setup and operate a complex for Mineral Sands processing for the corresponding mine. The complex would involve facilities for mining of Mineral Sands from the lease area, upgradation of the Mineral Sand and then separation of constituent minerals.

The Mineral Sands shall be excavated through suitable methods of mining. Such mined Mineral Sand shall be pumped into processing units ("Wet Upgradation Plant" or "WUP"), where it shall be upgraded for Beach Sand Minerals i.e., unwanted gangue (quartz) shall be removed by gravity separation via equipment like spiral banks, trommel screen, teeter bed separator etc. Such operation in the WUP is referred as "Wet Upgradation". Accordingly, the upgraded output from WUPs shall be referred to as "HM Concentrate" and the quartz rich rejects shall be referred to as "Tailings". This is followed by separation of constituent minerals in the HM Concentrate in a mineral separation plant. The HM Concentrate may also undergo several intermediate upgradation plants prior to mineral separation.

Now, IREL intends to appoint a Mine Developer and Operator (MDO) for mining of Mineral Sand and its upgradation in WUP. The MDO shall undertake all required works for setting up the facilities for such operations, and then subsequently operate it. This shall include including preparation of Mining plan, facilitate IREL in getting all statutory clearances, permits & approvals, facilitation in land acquisition or consent from landowners for a short period for surface operation, deployment of equipment & machinery, erection and commissioning of WUPs and other infrastructures, operation & maintenance of the deployed equipment, machinery & plants, delivery of HM Concentrate to IREL at designated delivery point and any other related activities.

In this regard, IREL invites Expression of Interest from experienced and resourceful MDOs to harness the Brahmagiri deposit.

7. Scope of Work

7.1. Broad Scope of the Work for the MDO

The MDO provider is expected to perform the following scope of activities for this project:

- 1. To prepare Mining Plan and undertake all activities for obtaining approval on it, on behalf of IREL.
- 2. To procure all approvals, clearances, permits and licences for development and operation of the facility throughout the tenure of the services
- 3. To assist IREL in obtaining consent from the occupier of the surface of the land over which the lease has been granted. Such consent shall be obtained for a short duration of time for undertaking operations over that surface as per the provisions of Atomic Minerals Concession Rules, 2016.
- 4. To assist IREL in acquisition of land and undertake all R&R related activities in relation to it, if required for any activity necessary for the operations.
- 5. To construct and commission the Wet Upgradation Plant.
- 6. To deploy the equipment and machinery as per the approved Mining Plan, excavate the Mineral Sand from the lease area and delivering it to the Wet Upgradation Plant.
- 7. To operate and maintain the Wet Upgradation Plant to upgrade the excavated Mineral Sand for the Heavy Mineral content in it.
- 8. To backfill the tailings discharged from the Wet Upgradation Plant into the mined-out area of the mine lease.
- 9. To deploy all manpower and workmen for the operations in accordance with the applicable laws.
- 10. To arrange for supply of all utilities including water, power and fuel at its own cost for operation.
- 11. To ensure compliance of applicable laws during development, construction and operational works for this project.

A detailed scope of the work will be provided in the RFP stage.

8. Route for Participation

- (a) The Bidders may participate as a sole bidder (single entity)
- (b) The Bidders may also constitute a consortium for participation.

- (c) IREL shall not be responsible in any way for such costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the Bidding Process.
- (d) Subsequent to EoI evaluation and based on the inputs received from capable parties, detailed scope of work and RFP will be finalized and the same will be floated at a later stage for participation by bidders to execute the aforesaid work.

11. Instructions for Online Bid Submission

The bidders are required to submit soft copies of their bids electronically on the CPP Portal, using valid Digital Signature Certificates. The instructions given below are meant to assist the bidders in registering on the CPP Portal, prepare their bids in accordance with the requirements and submitting their bids online on the CPP Portal.

More information useful for submitting online bids on the CPP Portal may be obtained at https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app.

REGISTRATION

- 1) Bidders are required to enrol on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL: https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app) by clicking on the link "Online bidder Enrolment" on the CPP Portal which is free of charge.
- 2) As part of the enrolment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique username and assign a password for their accounts.
- 3) Bidders are advised to register their valid email address and mobile numbers as part of the registration process. These would be used for any communication from the CPP Portal.
- 4) Upon enrolment, the bidders will be required to register their valid Digital Signature Certificate (Class II or Class III Certificates with signing key usage) issued by any Certifying Authority recognized by CCA India (e.g. Sify / nCode / eMudhra etc.), with their profile.
- 5) Only one valid DSC should be registered by a bidder. Please note that the bidders are responsible to ensure that they do not lend their DSCs to others which may lead to misuse.
- 6) Bidder then logs in to the site through the secured log-in by entering their user ID / password and the password of the DSC / e-Token.

SEARCHING FOR TENDER DOCUMENTS

- There are various search options built in the CPP Portal, to facilitate bidders to search active tenders by several parameters. These parameters could include Tender ID, Organization Name, Location, Date, Value, etc. There is also an option of advanced search for tenders, wherein the bidders may combine a number of search parameters such as Organization Name, Form of Contract, Location, Date, Other keywords etc. to search for a tender published on the CPP Portal.
- 2) Once the bidders have selected the tenders they are interested in, they may download the required documents / tender schedules. These tenders can be moved to the respective 'My Tenders' folder. This would enable the CPP Portal to intimate the bidders through SMS / e-mail in case there is any corrigendum issued to the tender document.
- 3) The bidder should make a note of the unique Tender ID assigned to each tender, in case they want to obtain any clarification / help from the Helpdesk.

PREPARATION OF BIDS

- 1) Bidder should take into account any corrigendum published on the tender document before submitting their bids.
- 2) Please go through the tender advertisement and the tender document carefully to understand the documents required to be submitted as part of the bid. Please note the number of covers in which the bid documents have to be submitted, the number of documents - including the names and content of each of the document that need to be submitted. Any deviations from these may lead to rejection of the bid.
- 3) Bidder, in advance, should get ready the bid documents to be submitted as indicated in the tender document / schedule and generally, they can be in PDF / XLS / RAR / DWF/JPG formats. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document.
- 4) To avoid the time and effort required in uploading the same set of standard documents which are required to be submitted as a part of every bid, a provision of uploading such standard documents (e.g. PAN card copy, annual reports, auditor certificates etc.) has been provided to the bidders. Bidders can use "My Space" or "Other Important Documents" area available to them to upload such documents. These documents may be directly submitted from the "My Space" area while submitting a bid and need not be uploaded again and again. This will lead to a reduction in the time required for bid submission process.

SUBMISSION OF BIDS

- 1) Bidder should log into the site well in advance for bid submission so that they can upload the bid in time i.e., on or before the bid submission time. Bidder will be responsible for any delay due to other issues.
- 2) The bidder has to digitally sign and upload the required bid documents one by one as indicated in the tender document.
- 3) Bidders are requested to note that they should necessarily submit their financial bid in the format provided and no other format is acceptable. If the price bid has been given as a standard BoQ format with the tender document, then the same is to be downloaded and to be filled by all the bidders. Bidders are required to download the BoQ file, open it and complete the white colored (unprotected) cells with their respective financial quotes and other details (such as name of the bidder). No other cells should be changed. Once the details have been completed, the bidder should save it and submit it online, without changing the filename. If the BoQ file is found to be modified by the bidder, the bid will be rejected.
- 4) The server time (which is displayed on the bidders' dashboard) will be considered as the standard time for referencing the deadlines for submission of the bids by the bidders, opening of bids etc. The bidders should follow this time during bid submission.
- 5) All the documents being submitted by the bidders would be encrypted using PKI encryption techniques to ensure the secrecy of the data. The data entered cannot be viewed by unauthorized persons until the time of bid opening. The confidentiality of the bids is maintained using the secured Socket Layer 128 bit encryption technology. Data storage encryption of sensitive fields is done. Any bid document that is uploaded to the server is subjected to symmetric encryption using a system generated symmetric key. Further this key is subjected to asymmetric encryption using buyers/bid openers public keys. Overall, the uploaded tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized bid openers.

- 6) The uploaded tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized bid openers.
- 7) Upon the successful and timely submission of bids (i.e. after Clicking "Freeze Bid Submission" in the portal), the portal will give a successful bid submission message & a bid summary will be displayed with the bid no. and the date & time of submission of the bid with all other relevant details.
- 8) The bid summary has to be printed and kept as an acknowledgement of the submission of the bid. This acknowledgement may be used as an entry pass for any bid opening meetings.
